#### Objective

#### Conditions and procedures

*General conditions for admittance*

The candidate must be enrolled at the University of Sfax that signed the Inter Institutional Agreement within the framework of Erasmus + Programme, with the " **Apollonia University - Iasi – Romania**. The student must be **preselected** and **nominated** by the University of Sfax

#### Application Procedures

- Copy of the Passport
- Knowledge of English (B2- Certificate)
- Transcript of Records (from the BAC)
- Short CV
- Short version of the research proposal (signed by the PhD student and the academic tutor)
- Certificate of enrolment
- Invitation letter

#### FUNDING

##### About grants

In the framework of the Erasmus+ programme and according to its regulations, all mobility activities are conditional upon the signature of an interinstitutional agreement between **Apollonia University** and the partner university before the start of the mobility.



### **The grant includes:**

- **800€ per month**
- An additional amount to cover travel expenses **275€**

### **Pre-selection criteria at the home university**

The home university will provide a pre-selection of candidates according to the following general criteria:

- Average grade.
- Language skills.
- Any other elements indicated by the student in the application (other learning experiences, specific academic interests, etc.).
- Research plan
- Additional criteria i.e: membership in science clubs or associations, participation in conferences and other mobility programmes etc. (it is up to the sending institution to include the criteria or not)
- Students who meet one or more of the following inclusion and diversity criteria established by the Erasmus+ program:
  - disability (i.e. participants with special needs): people with mental (intellectual, cognitive, learning), physical, sensory or other disabilities;
  - educational difficulties: young people with learning difficulties; early school-leavers; low qualified adults; young people with poor school performance.
  - economic obstacles: people with a low standard of living, low income, dependence on social welfare system or homeless; young people in long-term unemployment or poverty; people in debt or with financial problems.
  - cultural differences: immigrants or refugees or descendants from immigrant or refugee families; people belonging to a national or ethnic minority; people with linguistic adaptation and cultural inclusion difficulties.
  - health problems: people with chronic health problems, severe illnesses, or psychiatric conditions.
  - social obstacles: people facing discrimination because of gender, age, ethnicity, religion, sexual orientation, disability, etc.; people with limited social skills or anti-social or risky behaviors; people in a precarious situation; (ex-)offenders, (ex-)drug or alcohol abusers; young and/or single parents; orphans.
  - geographical obstacles: people from remote or rural areas; people living in small islands or in peripheral regions; people from urban problem zones; people from less serviced areas (limited public transport, poor facilities).
