The DEEP BLUE project aims at developing skills and building capacities through enhancing geopolitical dialogue and international scientific cooperation (Science Diplomacy) in the Western Mediterranean Region. Partners from Italy, Spain and Tunisia could promote north-south and south-north cooperation between public and private sectors. Different stakeholders from these countries can eventually implement education and training paths to gain advanced shared knowledge and develop a common methodological ground regarding the key sectors of Blue Economy in the Mediterranean Basin.

Training-of-Trainers: Effective management and sustainable development of fisheries resources and aquaculture aims to build a shared advanced scientific knowledge and create a common methodological ground for high-skilled experts on Blue Growth in the Western Mediterranean Region in promoting sustainable exploitation of the water resources such as small-scale fisheries and aquaculture. The Training program tackles issues related to the development and sharing of tools for effective management and sustainable development of fisheries resources; research and application of new approaches to fisheries management; as well as considering the environmental aspects and lack of regulation of the high seas fisheries sector for migratory species. The Training course is related to the following modules:

- Policies and Aquaculture Management
- Policies and Fisheries Management
- Biodiversity & Non-indigenous species (NIS)
- Aquaculture

Due to the covid-19 virus outbreak and current restrictions on mobility, the training will be offered in a series of live webinar sessions and four documentary videos related to fisheries and aquaculture will be shared with participants.

Participants: the web training is dedicated to 30 participants from all Mediterranean countries. It is designed for researchers, PhD students, young scientists, engineers and high qualified professionals in marine sciences or maritime sectors.
