

Call for Applications

Scholarship to study at University of Sassari (Italy) in the framework of the European Programme ERASMUS+ KA1

Objective

The Erasmus+ Programme – mobility for study offers the possibility to spend a period of studies at **University of Sassari** for **Master Students** from the University of Sfax

Mobility students will be awarded a scholarship, will attend courses and will use all the facilities of The University of Sassari on an equal basis as the enrolled students.

All passed exams previously approved in the **Learning Agreement**, will be recognised by the home institution (University of Sfax).

Mobility periods

Master's level: 6 months

Fields of Education and Training

Urban, Regional, Environmental, Landscape Planning and Design

Financing

Grant amount: **850 € per month.**

Travel grant: **275 €**

The students' grant will be allocated as follows:

- ✓ Pre-financing: travel grant + the corresponding amount for one month (1125 €) in cash on students' arrival in Sassari
- ✓ 70% of the remaining amount: deposit on the credit card UNISS (to be delivered for free on students' arrival in Sassari)
- ✓ Remaining 30%: deposit on the credit card UNISS at the end of the mobility, upon completion of all academic activities.

All financial details will be duly described in the **Grant Agreement** that students will sign before their mobility starts.

Conditions and procedures

General conditions for admittance

The candidate student must be enrolled at the University of Sfax that signed the Inter Institutional Agreement within the framework of Erasmus + Programme, with the University of Sassari.

Please find the relevant dates for this first semester awarding period (**September 2017**)

The student must be **preselected** and **nominated** by the University of Sfax

Language requirements and language support

Main language of instruction is Italian. However, some lessons can be held in English.

The University of Sassari organizes free Italian language courses addressed to incoming students throughout the academic year. Furthermore, intensive courses are organized in September and in February, just before the beginning of each semester.

Intensive courses allow incoming students to acquire or strengthen a basic level of Italian.

Students are strongly encouraged to arrive in time to attend the intensive language courses.

Insurance

All participants need to have the following insurance during the mobility:

- ✓ Health
- ✓ Third-party liability
- ✓ Accident (included repatriation in case of death)

Application Procedures

- Copy of the Passport
- Knowledge of Italian and English
- Transcript of Records (Bac + L1+L2+L3)
- Copy of bachelor degree
- Acknowledgement of enrolment
- Short CV
- Motivation letter
- Learning Agreement signed by the student, the academic tutor and the director of the home institution (see annex I)

The documents must be submitted to the home Institution (International Relations Office) at the following address: University of Sfax, Airport road km 0.5 P.O.BOX 1169 – 3029 – Sfax . The home Institution will be responsible of selection procedures on the basis **transparent and fair criteria**.

The deadline for applying is **fixed at 15 May 2017**.
