

Call for Applications Staff mobility call

University of Sassari (Italy) in the framework of the European Programme ERASMUS+ KA1

Objective

The Erasmus+ Programme – mobility offers the possibility to spend a period of teaching at **University of Sassari** for **Academic Staff (Environmental sciences and agriculture)** from the University of Sfax.

Erasmus+ International Credit Mobility KA107 is a project approved in the framework of Erasmus+ programme, aiming at fostering cooperation in the field of Higher Education between European and partner countries Institutions through a mobility scheme addressing staff exchanges. The current call for applications covers a bilateral mobility between the University of Sassari as Higher Education Institution in the EU and Higher Education Institutions in partner countries.

Conditions and procedures:

General conditions for admittance

Applications should be submitted to the home institution that will be responsible for selecting the participants, according to previously established criteria. All fundamental principles and mobility requirements set out in the Inter-Institutional Agreement must be respected. The selection procedure must be fair, transparent, coherent and documented and shall be made available to all parties involved in the selection process.

In order to apply for a grant within the framework of *Erasmus + KA107- ICM* project, candidates must comply with the **following general requirements**:

- They must be official members of their home University, that is: Staff must be employed in the Partner Higher Education Institution.
- The official language requested for the application is English.
- Minimum language recommended level is: B2 English level.

Fields of Teaching

- Environmental Sciences
- Agriculture

Mobility periods

- 1 Staff Mobility for teaching: 5 days (excluding travel days)
- 1 Staff Mobility for teaching: 12 days (excluding travel days)

Financing

- Grant amount: **140 € per day**.
- Travel grant: **275 €**

All financial details will be duly described in the **Grant Agreement** that staff will sign before their mobility starts.

Teaching Mobility:

A teaching activity must include minimum 8 hours teaching per week. If the mobility lasts longer than one week, the minimum number of teaching hours for an incomplete week should be proportional to the duration of that week.

Mobility Period:

The mobility may take place from February to June 2023, according to the University of Sassari academic calendar.

Application Procedures:

- Copy of the Passport
- Short CV
- Motivation letter
- Teaching Agreement for Academic Staff (see annex I)
- Letter of invitation
